**Brief Summary:**

The Department of Relief & Disaster Management, Government of Manipur was setup in 2006 as per the provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 This Department consists of Disaster Management Institute, Civil Defence and State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) as components.

**Institutional Arrangement:**

The Department is vested with responsibilities of not only providing relief assistance to the victims of various natural calamities but also responsible for research, imparting trainings, awareness programs to various stakeholders including communities and volunteers and to take up measure on pre and post disaster management comprising of and prevention, mitigation, preparedness and rescue, relief (relief efforts, emergency supplies such as food, water, medical aid etc. and providing temporary shelter to affected populations), response, recovery, reconstruction etc.

**PROJECTS / SCHEMES:**

**A. Completed Scheme:**

- i. **Up-scaling of Aapda Mitra Scheme:**  
Training of 800 community volunteers from 16 districts in disaster response has been successfully completed in January, 2026.
- ii. **Implementation of Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (2023–2025).**
- iii. **Strengthening of District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMAs) in hazard-prone districts, including Chandel District (2023–2025).**

**B. On-going Projects / Schemes**

**i. State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF):**

This Department has identified twenty-four (24) hazard-specific mitigation projects under the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FC) Award for the year 2020–2021, which were sanctioned during 2024–2025 under the State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) across nine (9) districts - Imphal West, Bishnupur, Thoubal, Imphal East, Ukhrul, Senapati, Kangpokpi, Tamenglong and Noney. The twenty-four (24) projects pertain to flash floods, cyclones, and landslides and are being undertaken in the State at a total cost of Rs. 9.36 crore,

**C. Up-Coming projects and schemes:**

**i. Yuva Aapda Mitra Scheme:**

MoU signed to train 2,429 volunteers from NCC, NSS, NYKs, and Bharat Scouts & Guides (B&SG) during the current financial year.

**ii. Forest Fire Risk Mitigation Project:**

PPR approved by MHA through Sub Committee of the National Executive Committee (SC-NEC) for implementation in 49 villages across 10 districts of Manipur.

**iii. National Landslide Risk Reduction and Mitigation Programme:**

Approved by MHA for implementation for 9 sites (6 in Tamenglong, 3 in Ukhrul); first installment of central share has also been released.

The project will be implemented in the 6 (six) sites of Tamenglong District and 3 (three) sites in Ukhrul District. Further, the 1st instalment of the central share has also been released.

## **ACHIEVEMENT DURING THE LAST 1 (ONE) YEAR:**

### **1. CAPACITY BUILDING:**

- i. Operation Abhyaas” black-out mock drills were conducted at the State level at three locations on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2025, followed by district-level drills across all districts.
- ii. Basic Disaster Management training was imparted to 1,150 Government Higher Secondary Teachers from Imphal West, Imphal East, Bishnupur, Thoubal, and other valley districts during July and November 2025 at various training venues.
- iii. 438 NCC cadets were trained on medical emergency response by the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) from 17<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2025.
- iv. NGOs of Manipur were trained on Basic Disaster Management on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2025.
- v. Aapda Mitra volunteers from Churachandpur and Pherzawl Districts participated in the district-level 77<sup>th</sup> Republic Day Parade on 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2026; additionally, two (02) Aapda Mitra volunteers, along with one official from Manipur, witnessed the Republic Day celebration held on the same day in New Delhi.
- vi. Participation of the Department in the 77<sup>th</sup> Republic Day Tableau based on the theme of earthquake.
- vii. In response to the ongoing forest fire at Dzukou Valley in Senapati District, twenty (20) personnel of the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) have been deployed.

### **2. INFRASTRUCTURE:**

Four (04) FRP inflatable boats (4.5 m) with 30 HP OBMs were procured through GeM and after inspection by the Technical Committee, were handed over to the Commandant, SDRF, Manipur, on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2025.

### **3. SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATION:**

Nine (09) response operations were undertaken during 2025, comprising seven (07) drowning/body recovery cases, one (01) VVIP sanitization duty-visit of Hon’ble PM and one (01) flood evacuation operation, most of the operations were successful.
