*The House assembled at 11.00 a.m. of Tuesday, the 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2023 in the Assembly Hall with the Hon'ble Speaker, Shri Th. Satyabrata Singh in the Chair.*

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Hon'ble Chief Minister, 11 Hon'ble Cabinet Ministers, Hon'ble Chairman (Hill Areas Committee) and 44 Elected Members.

**QUESTIONS:**

- (a) Hon'ble Minister (Forest, Env & Climate Change) made a reply to Starred Question No. 118 asked by Shri K. Ranjit Singh, MLA regarding plantation of trees from 2018-2022
- (b) Hon'ble Chief Minister made a reply to Starred Question No.119 asked by Shri Surjakumar Okram, MLA regarding outstanding dues for retired employees.
- (c) Hon'ble Minister (Water Resources) made a reply to Starred Question No.120 asked by Shri Ngursanglur Sanate, MLA regarding development of Inland Waterways in Barak River from Jiri Ghat to Tipaimukh Village.
- (d) Hon'ble Chief Minister made a reply to Starred Question No.121 asked by Shri K. Ranjit Singh, MLA regarding tax collection under MLR & LR Act.
- (e) Hon'ble Chief Minister made a reply to Starred Question No.122 asked by Shri Surjakumar Okram, MLA regarding restoration of Old Pension Scheme for the State Government employees.
- (f) Hon'ble Minister (Agriculture) made a reply to Starred Question No. 123 asked by Shri Ngursanglur Sanate, MLA regarding signing of MoU with AGROVET LTD. for plantation of edible oil and oil palm.

**CALLING ATTENTION:**

Shri K. Ranjit Singh called the attention of the Chief Minister (in-charge of Home) on the reported killing of one person at Changoubung Village in Kangpokpi District on 12/02/23. Citing the 13<sup>th</sup> February edition of the “Sanaleibak” newspaper regarding the mysterious death of Akoijam Nonganba from Kwakeithel Konjeng Leikai, at Changoubung village in Kangpokpi District, he queried about the steps being taken up by the government regarding the incident. He further enquired about the connection between the death of the said person and NSCN(IM) and suggested that whether the case could be handed over to the CBI or NIA.

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in charge of Home) replying to the calling attention condemned such kind of killing and informed that a suo-motto case had been registered in connection with the killing and the government had arrested two accused namely, Moses Gonmei, who claimed himself to be a Deputy Kilonser of NSCN (IM) and Thokchom Sonia, the girl friend of the deceased from Kwakeithel Thokchom Leikai. He added that the government is making all effort to nab the remaining co-accused named Stephen, a cadre of NSCN (IM), who is absconding. A Special Investigation Team (SIT) had been constituted to investigate the case, he inform and added that every effort is being made to solve the case.
