*Thursday, the 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022*

*The House assembled at 9:00 am of Thursday, the 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 in the Assembly Hall with the Hon'ble Speaker Protem, Shri S. Rajen Singh in the Chair.*

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Hon'ble Chief Minister, 5 Cabinet Ministers and 53 Elected Members.

**ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE SECRETARY:**

The Secretary, Manipur Legislative Assembly announced the order by the Hon'ble Governor, Manipur dated 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2022.

**ELECTION OF SPEAKER:**

Hon'ble Speaker *Protem*, Shri S. Rajen Singh announced that he had received 11 sets of motions all in favour of Shri Th. Satyabrata Singh, MLA for election to the office of the Speaker, Manipur Legislative Assembly. As all the motions were identical, the motion moved by Dr. S. Ranjan Singh, MLA and seconded by Shri K. Robindro Singh, MLA was adopted by the House and Shri Th. Satyabrata Singh was elected unanimously as the Speaker of the 12<sup>th</sup> Manipur Legislative Assembly.

*Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri N. Biren Singh and Shri O. Ibobi Singh, MLA conducted the newly elected Speaker to the Chair.*

S/Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister, K. Govindas Singh, O. Ibobi Singh and S. Rajen Singh, MLAs participated in the felicitation of the newly elected Speaker.

Hon'ble Speaker, Shri Th. Satyabrata Singh expressed gratitude to all the Hon'ble Members for choosing him as the Speaker of the 12<sup>th</sup> Manipur Legislative Assembly and further added that he would work earnestly to uphold the dignity and decorum of the august House. He further sought the cooperation of all the Hon'ble Members of the august House while discharging his duties.

The Speaker, Manipur Legislative Assembly moved a resolution on the demise of the following Members:

- (i) Shri Leitanthem Tomba Singh, former Member of the Manipur Legislative Assembly from 31-Thoubal Assembly Constituency.
- (ii) Shri A. Aza, former Member of the Manipur Legislative Assembly from 45-Chingai (ST) Assembly Constituency.
- (iii) Shri Wahengbam Angou Singh, former Member of Legislative Assembly from 21-Naoriya Pakhanglakpa Assembly Constituency and former Member of Rajya Sabha.
- (iv) Shri Mayengbam Manihar Singh, former Member of the Manipur Legislative Assembly from 36-Wabagai Assembly Constituency.
- (v) Shri Athuibo Daimai, former Member of the Electoral College, 1952-57, the Manipur Territorial Council, 1957-62 and the first Manipur Territorial Assembly, 1962-67 from Aimol Assembly Constituency.

- (v) The Manipur Legislature (Removal of Disqualifications) (Sixth Amendment) Bill, 2021 (Bill No. 18 of 2021) which was assented on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.
- (vi) The Manipur (Courts)(Second Amendment) Bill, 2021 (Bill No. 23 of 2021) which was assented on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.
