*Saturday, the 26<sup>th</sup> March 2022*

*The House assembled at 11.00 am of Saturday, the 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 in the Assembly Hall with the Hon'ble Speaker, Shri Th. Satyabrata Singh in the Chair.*

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Hon'ble Chief Minister, 5 Cabinet Ministers and 52 Elected Members.

**PAPER LAID ON THE TABLE OF THE HOUSE:**

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister laid "The Manipur Nursing Council Rules, 2008" on the Table of the House.

**CALLING ATTENTION:**

Shri K. Ranjit Singh, MLA called the attention of the Chief Minister on the indefinite bandh/blockade of National Highway 2 called by Southern Angami Public Organization (SAPO) demanding the removal of security outpost and personnel from Kezoltsa area in Dzuko valley. He said that the bandh is causing immense inconvenience to travellers and transportation of essential commodities into the state and enquired if the government has taken up any measures to solve it. He further stressed that the issue about the disputed area in Dzuko valley is chronic and urged the House to resolve for constituting a 'Boundary Commission' to solve such issues once and for all.

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister clarified that the security outpost is truly constructed within the boundary of the state jurisdiction and informed that the matter has been intimated to the Government of Nagaland and the Union Home Ministry. He further clarified that there is no boundary dispute between the two neighbouring states of Manipur and Nagaland and added that the issue is only due to SAPO, a local ethnic community based organization, which claims that the land belongs to them. The government is working on means to amicably solve the issue diplomatically at the earliest, he added and mentioned that measures have been taken up for bringing back the stranded people.

**LEAVE OF ABSENCE:**

Hon'ble Speaker made an announcement that Shri L.M. Khaute, MLA had applied for leave of absence for the day.

*The House agreed and leave was granted.*

**ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE SPEAKER:**

Hon'ble Speaker announced that the Parliamentary Procedure to be followed by the Hon'ble Members regarding decorum and etiquette has been placed on the Table of the House for reference.

**CONSIDERATION AND PASSING OF APPROPRIATION BILLS:**

(i) Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister moved:

*“that the Manipur Appropriation (No.1) Bill, 2022 be taken into consideration”.*

And also moved that the Bill be passed.

*After clause by clause consideration, the Manipur Appropriation (No.1) Bill, 2022 was unanimously passed by the House.*

(ii) Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister moved:

*“that the Manipur Appropriation (No.2) Bill, 2022 be taken into consideration”.*

And also moved that the Bill be passed.

*After clause by clause consideration, the Manipur Appropriation (No.2) Bill, 2022 was unanimously passed by the House.*
