The period of notice required for the given business are as follows:

1. Questions - Not less than 10 (ten) clear days.
2. Private Members' Resolution - 5(five) days.
3. Government Resolution - 3(three) days.
4. Private Members' Bill - 5(five) days.
5. Amendment to Bills - 1(one) day.
6. Cut Motions - 2(two) days.
7. Half-an-Hour Discussion - 2(two) days.
8. Amendment to Resolutions - 36 Hours before the day fixed for discussion of the Resolution.
9. Other Notices - As prescribed under the relevant Rules.
