Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister to move :

“that a supplementary sum not exceeding Rs. 35,17,28,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 1 - State Legislature.”

- (ii) DEMAND NO. 2 - COUNCIL OF MINISTERS :
Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister to move :
