3. Discussion and Voting on Demands for Grants, 2023-2024.

#### (I) DEMAND NO.1 -STATE LEGISLATURE:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 252,20,86,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 1 - State Legislature.”*

#### (II) DEMAND NO. 2 - COUNCIL OF MINISTERS :

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 15,27,88,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 2 - Council of Ministers.”*

#### (III) DEMAND NO. 3 - SECRETARIAT:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 180,49,77,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 3 - Secretariat.”*

#### (IV) DEMAND NO. 6 - TRANSPORT:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 62,34,74,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 6 - Transport.”*

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 3291,78,35,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 10 - Education.”*

On account of :-

- (i) Delay in systematic appointment of Principal, Vice-Principal, Headmaster and Asst. Headmaster of schools.
- (ii) Delay in absorption of staffs after conversion of aided-colleges into full-fledged colleges (6 nos.) .
- (iii) Lack of proper policy to convert Government aided schools into full-fledged Government schools.
- (iv) Need of proper policy to fill up vacant sanctioned posts (teaching and non teaching staffs) in Government-aided school.
- (v) Inability to manage administration of Government aided colleges as per Education Code 1982.
- (vi) Inability to solve the confusion regarding the number of letters in Meetei/Meitei mayek script.
- (vii) Improper recruitment process in filling up vacant posts in the Education Department.
- (viii) Lack of teaching and non teaching staff in Dhanamanjuri University leading to the failures of academic approaches and administrative failures.
- (ix) Lack of adequate staff in Hindi Teachers' Training college.
- (x) Non-appointment of regular Principals in Government colleges.
- (xi) Non-appointment of librarians in colleges and schools.
- (xii) Lack of preparation to fully implement NEP 2020.
- (xiii) Non-appointment of regular teaching staff in SCERT including the post of Director.

(VI) DEMAND NO. 16 - CO-OPERATION:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 41,72,37,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No.16 - Co-operation.”*

(VII) DEMAND NO. 39 - SERICULTURE:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 51,25,69,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024 in respect of Demand No. 39 - Sericulture.”*
