"that a sum not exceeding Rs. 15,68,46,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 2 - Council of Ministers".

(III) DEMAND NO. 3 - SECRETARIAT :

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

"that a sum not exceeding Rs. 170,62,45,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 3 - Secretariat".

(IV) DEMAND NO. 12 - MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT :
