Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister to move:

“that a supplementary sum not exceeding Rs. 22,41,19,000 be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2024 in respect of Demand No.1- State Legislature”.

(ii) DEMAND NO. 3- SECRETARIAT:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister to move:

“that a supplementary sum not exceeding Rs. 2,36,30,000 be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2024 in respect of Demand No.3- Secretariat”.
