- (I) DEMAND NO. 20 - COMMUNITY AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT:
Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

"that a sum not exceeding Rs. 4046,34,14,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 20 - Community and Rural Development".

MOTION FOR DISAPPROVAL OF POLICY CUT :

"that the amount of the demand be reduced to Re. 1/-"

On account of :-

- (i) Lack of proper policy for release of funds in time regarding:-
 - (a) Payment of 1st installment of 1st tranche of Central Assistance of MGNREGA towards wage.
 - (b) Fund for Rural Local bodies Tied grant 1st installment which was released on 27/08/2021 by GOI.
 - (c) Fund for Rural Local bodies Basic grant (untied) 1st installment which was released on 08/05/2021 by GOI.
- (ii) Misappropriation of MGNREGA fund in Thoubal district and other districts of Manipur.
- (iii) Lack of quality control in construction under PMGSY.
- (iv) Lack of proper policy for maintenance of PMGSY roads as per guidelines.
- (v) Inability to provide provisions for 100 days employment under MGNREGA.
