#### (I) DEMAND NO. 10- EDUCATION:

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 2525,42,94,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 10 - Education.”*

#### On account of :-

- (i) Need of a policy to study Centre's decision for inclusion of hindi as a compulsory subject in the academic curriculum upto 10th standard.
- (ii) Need to maintain teaching staffs for primary schools and colleges.
- (iii) Inability to make final seniority list of lecturers.
- (iv) Non-transparency in the appointment of 206 lecturers.
- (v) Lack of proper policy for upgradation of Yairipok Universal College as Government-Aided-College and other Colleges.
- (vi) Need for improvement of School Phagathansi Mission.
- (vii) Inability to convert Aided Colleges to full fledged Government Colleges.
- (viii) Irregularities in the appointment of the Chairman of Board of Secondary Education Manipur.

- (xiii) Need to fill up the posts of lecturers in Sagolmang Hr/sec. school under School Phagathansi Mission.
- (xiv) Lack of preparedness to implement NEP at different levels.
- (xv) Delay in promotion of teachers.
- (xvi) Need to improve library infrastructures and lack of manpower in libraries.
- (xvii) Need for appropriate logistics in course design of schools and colleges.
- (xviii) Inability of SCERT to function in a responsible way.
- (xix) Inability to provide locally produced handloom uniforms.
