#### (I) DEMAND NO. 17 - AGRICULTURE :

Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs. 380,47,21,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 in respect of Demand No. 17 - Agriculture”.*

#### On account of :-

- (i) Lack of proper policy to distribute fertilizers to the farmer in time.

- (iii) Improper policy to save agricultural land in the State.
- (iv) Inability to distribute water pumps to the farmers.
