**RESUME OF WORK DONE DURING THE  
SECOND SESSION OF THE  
TWELFTH MANIPUR LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY**

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**1. Summoning of the Session:**

Hon'ble Governor of Manipur, La. Ganesan summoned the Members of the 12<sup>th</sup> Manipur Legislative Assembly to meet for its second Session on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 vide Order dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

**2. Duration of the Session:**

The duration of the 2<sup>nd</sup> session of the 12<sup>th</sup> Manipur Legislative Assembly was from 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 to 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Altogether 11(eleven) sittings were held on the following days:-

July, 2022 : 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>

August, 2022 : 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>

**3. Obituary References:**

(i) On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, Obituary References were held on the demise of Shri Yengkhom Thambal Singh, former Member of Manipur Legislative Assembly from 37-Kakching Assembly Constituency and loss of lives due to landslides at Marangching, Noney in the intervening night of 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 and in Pherzawl on 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

(ii) On 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2022, Obituary Reference was held on the demise of Shri Selkai Hrangchal, former Member of the Manipur Legislative Assembly from 55-Tipaimukh (ST) Assembly Constituency.

**10. Presentation of Business Advisory Committee Report :**

On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, Shri Th. Biswajit Singh, Hon'ble Minister presented the Second Report of the Business Advisory Committee, 2022 on the Table of the House. The House agreed and the Report was adopted.

**11. Election of the Three Financial Committees :**

On Wednesday, July 27, 2022 Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister moved the motion to elect 7(seven) Members each to the following Three Financial Committees for the year 2022-23 :-

- (i) Committee on Public Accounts
- (ii) Committee on Estimates
- (iii) Committee on Public Undertakings

Subsequently, Hon'ble Speaker announced the names of the elected Members on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. (see Appendix - III)

**12. Financial Business :**

- (i) On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri Th. Biswajit Singh, Minister presented the Demands for Excess Grants for the year 2017-18.
- (ii) On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri Th. Biswajit Singh, Minister presented the Budget Estimates, 2022-23.
- (iii) Shri Th. Biswajit Singh, Minister moved the motion for Vote on Accounts for the year, 2022-23 on July 25, 2022. The motion was adopted and the Vote on Accounts for the year 2022-23 amounting to Rs. 2933,71,72,083/- only was passed for the month of August pending detailed consideration and passing of the Demands for the full year 2022-23.

(iv) General Discussion on Budget Estimates, 2022-23 was held on July 26, 2022.

(v) Discussion and Voting on Demands for Excess Grants, 2017-18 was held on July 26, 2022.

### **13. Legislative Business :**

A. On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri Th. Biswajit Singh, Minister introduced the following Bills :-

- (i) The Code of Criminal Procedure (Manipur Third Amendment) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 3 of 2022).
- (ii) The Manipur Goods and Services Tax (Fifth Amendment) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 6 of 2022).
- (iii) The Manipur Value Added Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 8 of 2022).

The above Bills were passed on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

B. On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri Y. Khemchand Singh, Minister (in-charge of RD & PR) introduced "The Manipur Panchyati Raj (Eighth Amendment) Bill, 2022" (Bill No. 4 of 2022). It could not be passed and was referred to a Select Committee comprising of 5(five) Members. The Committee was to submit its report within 3(three) months. (see Appendix -V).

C. On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Smt. Nemcha Kipgen, Minister (in-charge of Textiles, Commerce & Industries) introduced "The Factories (Manipur Amendment) Bill, 2022" (Bill No. 7 of 2022). It was passed on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

D. On 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri L. Susindro Meitei, Minister (in-charge of CAF & PD) introduced the "The Legal Metrology (Manipur First Amendment) Bill, 2022" (Bill No. 9 of 2022). It was passed on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

E. On 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) introduced the following Bills:-

- (i) The Manipur Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 2022” (Bill No. 11 of 2022).
- (ii) The Manipur Appropriation (No. 5) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 13 of 2022).

The above Bills were passed on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

F. On 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) introduced the following Bills :-

- (i) The Manipur Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (Fourth Amendment) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 10 of 2022).
- (ii) The Manipur Staff Selection Commission Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 5 of 2022).
- (iii) The Manipur Land Revenue and Land Reforms (Seventh Amendment) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 14 of 2022).

The above Bills were passed on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2022.

G. On 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2022 Shri Letpao Haokip, Minister (in-charge of Tribal Affairs and Hills Department) introduced The Manipur (Hill Areas) District Councils (Sixth Amendment) Bill, 2022. It was passed on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

H. On 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2022 Shri Letpao Haokip, Minister (in-charge of Tribal Affairs and Hills Department) introduced The Manipur (Hill Areas) District Councils (Seventh Amendent) Bill, 2022. It was referred to Hill Areas Committee on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

I. On 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 Shri N. Biren Singh, Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) introduced the “The Manipur Appropriation (No. 4) Bill, 2022 (Bill No. 12 of 2022). It was passed by the House on the same day.

**14. Breach of Privilege :**

On 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 a motion of Breach of Privilege was raised by Hon'ble Member, Shri K. Meghachandra Singh regarding a news item in local dailies wherein a Vice-President of an organisation demanded clarification from Shri K. Ranjit Singh, MLA for the deliberation he made on the floor of the House about Pumlun Pat. The matter was referred to the Committee on Privilege and Ethics on the same day.

**15. Private Members' Resolution :**

During the Session, 2(two) Private Members' Resolutions were received and admitted. Both the resolutions were adopted after discussion in the House. (see Appendix-VI)

**16. Prorogation**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Twelfth Manipur Legislative Assembly was prorogued by the Hon'ble Governor of Manipur, La. Ganesan on October 14, 2022.
